3. Letter of Recommendation

- Identify the name, address and phone number of the adult (other than a relative) who has provided a letter of recommendation for you. This person should have direct involvement with you and your community service project and the recommendation should describe those connections and the project outcome(s).
- Please attach a copy of the letter of recommendation as an attachment to this application.

Submission Information

- Application must be submitted electronically or postmarked by January 31, 2019 by 12:00 midnight or delivered to the Office of Community Involvement by 4:00 p.m.
- For consideration of the award, applications must include all items listed. Please provide only the information requested but no additional materials such as photos, transcripts, newspaper articles, etc.
