- Any community ties you have developed through your service.
- Description of any leadership experiences you have had.
- Description of the impact on your life.

3. Extracurricular and Community Service Activities

- In your above essay or separately, please make sure you capture your years of involvement in service and roles and responsibilities in extracurricular activities as they relate to community service in each area of community and/or school service with which you have been involved.
- Provide documentation of your community service hours with a copy of your community service log signed by your supervisor or guidance counselor, or with a photo of your transcript showing your community service hours. (Preference will be given to applicants who provide documented proof of service hours.)
- If you work, list workplace activity and number of hours per week

- > Application must be submitted only electronically by March 18, 2024 by 12:00 midnight.
- For consideration of the award, the application must include all items listed. Please provide only the information requested but no additional materials such as photos, transcripts, newspaper articles, etc.
